Presider asks the Congregation:

Will you, who witness these vows, do all in your power to support these persons in this special vocation?

We will.

Presider: Let us pray.

Eternal God, foundation of all wisdom and source of all courage: Enlighten with your grace the members of this Discernment Committee. So guide their minds, so rule their hearts, so enflame their spirits, that your church may receive a faithful pastor, who will care for your people and equip them for ministry. We ask these things through your Son our Savior Jesus Christ. *Amen*.
